### Approval of March Meeting Minutes

- Meeting minutes were reviewed
- Motion made by Timko to approve, seconded by Laura. Passed unanimously

### Disc Golf Day

- Tina has been getting sponsors and working on DG day
- Could we use a couple of the boxes of discs for a raffle or silent auction. Everyone was fine with that.

### KCDG Marquee

#### Used Discs

##### (Pasted from the forum)

The KCDG is accumulating a few thousand discs in the storage area and this will continue. We can continue this or look at a couple of options.

Any discs 9 speed or lower is added to google sheets and these discs are given to schools, charities and non profits

Kathryn has made a Google Sheets to show where these donated disc go to and who the contact was.

A rough breakdown of returned discs from Kathryn is in the KCDG club storage and those discs are disc 10 speed or higher

-rough breakdown of returned discs

10% great shape

25% good shape

45% bad shape but usable

20% horrible shape are thrown away- dog bites, holes, cracked, bent etc....

There have been a couple ideas floating around- The discs that were not picked up by the owner and have since been picked up by Kathryn. She has marked out the name and number, stamped as not picked with KCDG stamp (Unclaimed Disc Donated By KC Disc Golf Inc), boxed up and taken to the KCDG storage unit.

1. Take the discs to a couple of the club events so the membership can bid on each disc or pay a marked price the club comes up with?

a. I think us shop owners should not be able to purchase these discs. This would be for the benefit

individual members.

b. I would also beware if someone comes in and buys several discs just to resell them?

2. The club could sell the discs that Kathryn has put in a closed box so no one could cherry pick the good discs out of the hundreds that come in. to the highest bidder which could be club members or disc shops.

a. There are on average 50+ discs per box.

b. The proceeds could go to a course fund so it's spent back where the members can see the money working.

c. The estimated average box of 50 discs selling for \$2 to \$4 each would bring in \$100 to \$200 each box.

Any suggestions from the board?

- Pete thinks we can get \$100-200 per box with 20-25 boxes. Thinking we could auction them off
- Folks are thinking the boxes will be closed
- Would be good to coordinate with KCDG events. Or do an annual fly mart
- Disc Storage Wars
- Will need someone to lead and execute it.
- Folks agreed that it's time to get some discs out of the storage unit
- Pete will move forward with Kathryn to get the process going

### Business Sponsored Leagues

- Sounds like there is a lot of interest from sponsors to get these going
- Some discussion if it is better to let sponsors drive the conversation
- Who wants to lead the effort?
- Gabo has already done some of this - posted in the forum
- Pete is willing to help with this
- It's likely that a lot of these will be in-kind donations
- Some of this can be done by the LDs
- It will be good to get something in writing (even just an email) that includes some description of what the two parties will get.
- We need to get this info out there before it gets any later
- It's likely that we may get sponsorship offers from institutions that don't fit our mission.

### Event Approval

- One round single at Prairie Center, need to approve it now.
- Motion was made by Pete, seconded by Timko. Passed unanimously.

### LD Compensation

- This has come up before, but wanted to bring this topic back up. The LDs brought it up at the last meeting.
- Should we cover part or all of the league fees for LDs
- Some discussion that they should pay if they are going to get part of the payout
- Folks want to waive the fees, but we can't payout cash if it hasn't been paid in.
- We estimate that it would cost KCDG about \$750 if we waive the (\$2) KCDG fees.

- Could we get gift certificates to the local vendors to give as gifts to the LDs?
- In the future, maybe we can do something more to say thank you to these volunteers
- Keep an eye out for a vote on this next week
- Timko is going to reach out to the LDs and give them a heads up

#### Discussion of course improvement mini-grant

- Folks in the group would like to move forward with this
- When would be able to do this? Cary thinks we could advertise pretty quickly and make a deadline of June 1.
- It would take 4-6 weeks to turn around the reviews
- Cary is going to take another look at the RFP draft and post an updated one on the forum

#### Who can cover Cary/Secretary duties for the next three meetings

- Laura is willing to, but her travel schedule can be hectic
- Michael said he would be the backup if she can't make a meeting

#### VP MO Update

- John Theiss is asking to be reimbursed for some grass seed (it's under \$350)
- JT is working with Waterworks getting trash pickup coordinated. They are planning to get five cans picked up weekly from the road.
- Still playing tag with new P&R Director at Pleasant Hill
  - Put two placements in, did some other maintenance
- Couple new pins out at Bad Rock, P&R mowed and burned the tall grass. Should look good in July. Two more pins need to be set.
- LaBenite is having some interesting visitors. Some talk of a re-design there.
- There will be workdays out at WW.
- Generally things are going well with KCMO
- Wilbur Young has three new pin locations
- Some interest in putting in a course north of the river for the kiddos. JT has been working on that.
